

Due to an increase in Meningococcal disease<sup>1</sup>, the Queensland Government is offering free Meningococcal ACWY vaccine to adolescents aged 15 - 19 years.

- Meningococcal disease follows a seasonal trend, peaking in winter and early spring.<sup>2</sup>
- \* Adolescents and young adults are typically at increased risk of contracting the disease due to closely mixing and living with many different people.<sup>2</sup>
- \* Vaccination with an ACWY vaccine helps protect against 4 of the 5 most common strains of Meningococcal disease (A, C, W and Y strains.)3

Vaccine provided FREE for 15 - 19 year olds.

Available for other age groups through private prescription from your GP.
