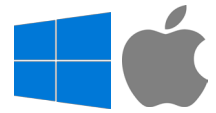


Internet Security



The internet will open you up to a wealth of great information and learning options, however being connected can also put your computer at risk from malicious people. You must make sure you have internet security / antivirus software installed to protect yourself.

You must always make sure to update your internet security software and scan your computer system regularly to keep it safe. All internet security software products will set this up for you by default when installing, so when you are connected to the internet it will automatically check for the latest updates. For more information on your systems configuration please check the support information for the software you have installed or consult your computer support company.

There are two basic options for internet security software, free or paid versions.

They both do the same job, the main difference is the paid versions offers phone support to assist you if you have issues or questions. Internet security software can be bought or downloaded online from each companies website or some products are available for purchase at your computer company.

If you are purchasing a new computer, tell them you are connecting to the internet and want to know what options are available. You can get a cheaper OEM version when buying a computer.
