2018 CTSDE Inter-house Swimming Carnival

Please note:

- ☐ The Carnival is held at the community swimming pool in Charters Towers. The pool is called **Kennedy Regiment Memorial Pool**. Address: 1 Plummer Street (corner of Church Street) Charters Towers
- ☐ The Junior Novelty Carnival will be run again this year. Students in Prep, Years 1 and 2 will be invited to take part in water games and races.
- ☐ Students born in 2010 are able to participate in the Swimming Carnival or the Junior Novelty Carnival. They must choose to stay at one or the other for the day - they cannot attend both. Please indicated on the above form which carnival your child will be attending.
- ☐ Students born in 2010, 2011, & 2012 are able to participate in the Non-Competitive 25m Freestyle race at the beginning of the carnival.
- ☐ After this race students born in 2010 must then choose to attend the Junior Novelty carnival or the Swimming Carnival. **Students are not permitted to be in both carnivals.**
- ☐ The 50m, 100m & 200m races will count towards age champion. Individual points - 1st = 8, 2nd = 5, 3rd = 3.
- ☐ Students who have turned or are turning 8 years old this year will be awarded age champion points for swimming in 25m events. Individual points - 1st =4, 2nd = 3, 3rd = 2.
- ☐ House points for participation are awarded for all races.
- ☐ There will be an open age group for students born 2000, 2001, 2002. This means that only two age champions (one male & one female) will be appointed for this entire group.
- ☐ Students may swim in a 25m race or a 50m of each stroke but not both for the same stroke.
