


Wally's Wetland Woes



Wally loved his home by the beach. He spent hours playing in the water, collecting shells and catching hermit crabs and snails that lived at the waters edge.




Unfortunately Wally and his family were unable to see the ocean from their house because big trees and mangroves blocked their view.



So one day Wally and his Dad decided that they would chop down the big trees and clear the mangroves in front of their house.




