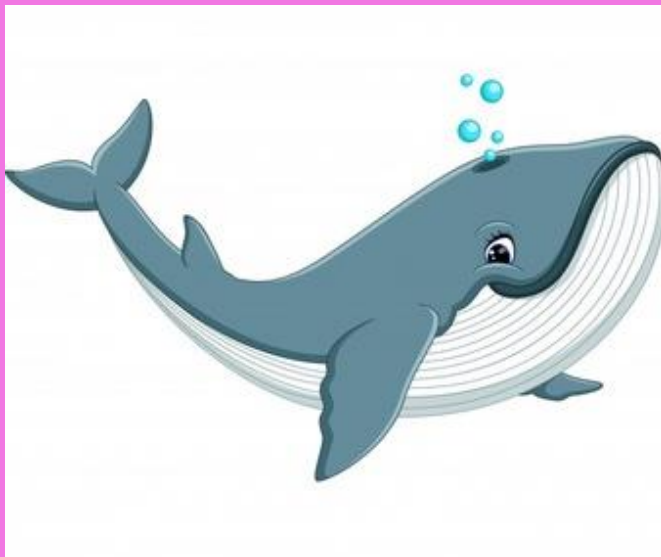


NALA THE WHALE
