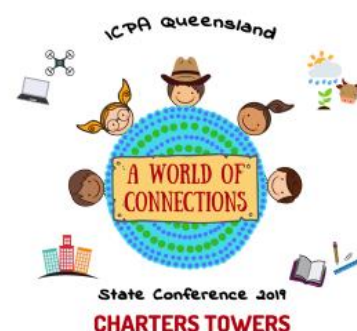


***Distance is no Barrier* –Performance at ICPA State Conference 2019**
